

REVIEW QUESTIONS

1. What is a missionary? (*Someone whose job it is to tell others about Jesus.*)
2. Who did God send to help those who follow Jesus? (*The Holy Spirit.*)
3. Before Paul (Saul) met Jesus, how did Paul treat Christians? (*He wanted to throw them in jail and kill them.*)
4. What happened to change Paul's mind about Jesus and change his life? (*Paul met Jesus on the road to Damascus.*)
5. What is an example of sin? (*Answers will vary.*)
6. What was the name of the other missionary who joined Paul? (*Barnabas.*)
7. What did Elymas do as Paul and Barnabas talked with the governor? (*Elymas made it hard for Paul and Barnabas to share God's truth with the governor; he kept arguing with them.*)
8. What is boldness? (*Boldness is doing what is right with courage.*)
9. What is something you can do to help you have boldness to tell others about Jesus? (*Pray; have other believers pray for you.*)
10. What does Gospel mean? (*Good News; the Good News that Jesus died and rose again to take the punishment for sin.*)
11. What did the governor do after he heard Paul and Barnabas's teaching about Jesus? (*He believed!*)
12. Why did Jesus die on the cross? (*To save me from the punishment of sin.*)

PRESCHOOL REVIEW QUESTIONS

1. What is something boys and girls do that is sin? (*Answers will vary.*)
2. What was the name of the man who argued against Paul? (*Elymas.*)
3. What did the governor do after listening to Paul? (*He believed on Jesus!*)
4. Why did Jesus die on the cross? (*To save me from the punishment of sin.*)

Review Game "Missionary Trek"

Materials:
"Paul's Journey" map
"Missionary Trek" reproducible
(See GNC Resource Pack.)

Instructions:
Divide the children into teams and assign each team a ship. Ask questions alternating between teams. When a child answers a question correctly, he gets to move his team's ship next to Jerusalem on the Bible Map. With each correct answer, the ship moves to the next city in Paul's first missionary journey—Antioch, Seleucia, Cyprus, Galatia then back to Antioch. Whichever team finishes the journey first wins!

Variation:
When a team's ship is moved have everyone on that team pretend to row.

Preschool Review Game "Missionary Trek Junior"

Play the game as described, but do not divide into teams. Play with one ship representing the whole class.
