1. Who went with Paul on his second missionary journey? (*Silas; Timothy.*)
2. What did Paul say to the evil spirit in the girl? (*"I command you in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her."*)
3. Why were Paul and Silas thrown in prison? (*The men were angry that Paul had sent the evil spirit away.*)
4. Who is with those who have trusted Jesus to help them even in hard times? (*God the Holy Spirit.*)
5. What is one way you can praise God? (*Sing to God; thank God for what He has done; answers may vary.*)
6. What caused the prison doors to open? (*God caused an earthquake.*)
7. Why was the jailor so afraid after the earthquake? (*He thought the prisoners had escaped.*)
8. What did the jailor ask Paul and Silas when he found them still in jail? (*"Sirs, what must I do to be saved?"*)
9. What is sin? (*Anything that goes against God's laws.*)
10. How can you be saved from your sin? (*By believing on Jesus.*)
11. If you believe on Jesus, what can you do when you are going through a hard time? (*Pray; sing a song of praise to God; remember God the Holy Spirit is with me; talk to an adult; answers may vary.*)
12. According to our memory verse, what does God use to work His mighty power in you? (*The Gospel.*)

PRESCHOOL REVIEW QUESTIONS

1. What did Paul and Silas do when they were thrown into prison? (*Prayed; sang praises to God.*)
2. What caused the prison doors to open? (*God caused an earthquake.*)
3. What happened on the third day after Jesus died? (*God raised Him from the dead.*)
4. How can you be saved from your sin? (*By believing on Jesus.*)

Review Game "Human Board Game"

Materials:
Paper
Cards labeled 1, 2, and 3

Instructions:
Tape 15 pieces of paper on the ground an age-appropriate distance apart. You can use different colors of construction paper if desired. Have three cards in your hand, labeled one through three. Divide the children into teams and pick a child from each team to be their team's "game piece." Have the children who are playing as the game pieces stand at the beginning of the board. Ask questions, alternating between teams. When a child answers a question correctly, he gets to pick one of the numbered cards in your hand to determine how far his team will advance on the game board. The first team to reach the end or the team that is farthest when time or questions run out wins.

Variation:
When a one is drawn have children of that team shout hurray! When a two is drawn have them spin around twice. When a three is drawn have them jump three times.

Preschool Review Game "One Step at a Time"

Have the children line up on one side of the room while you stand about eight steps away from them. When a child answers a question correctly, all the children get to take one step forward. Repeat until the children reach you.
